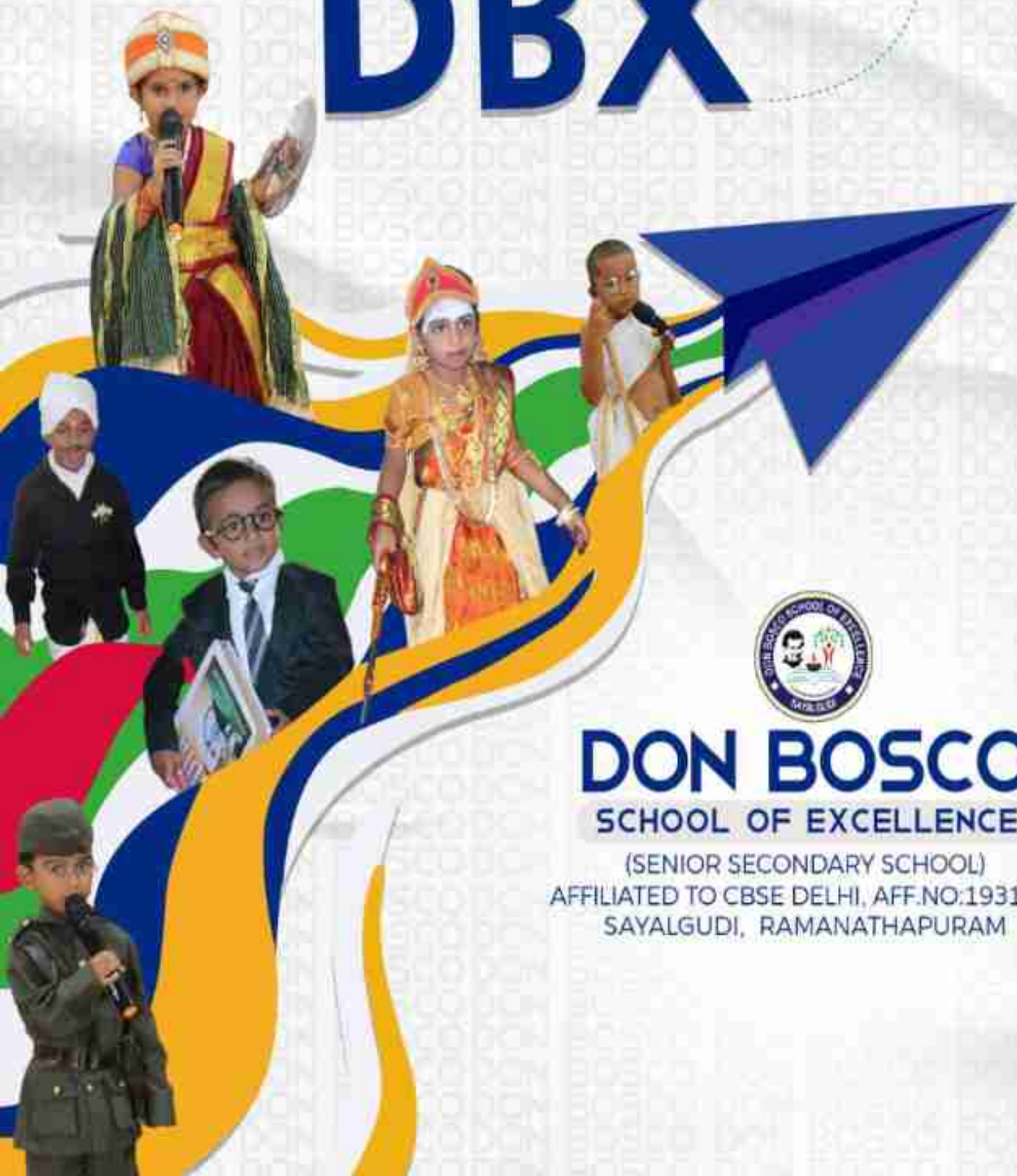

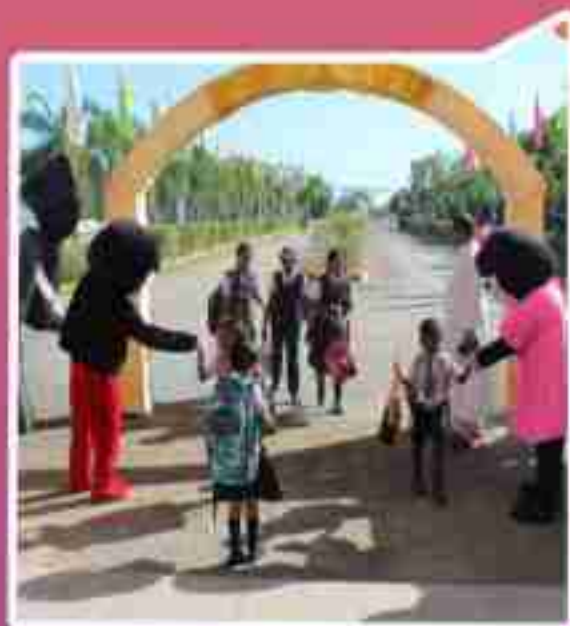
Inauguration New Academic Year 2025-26.

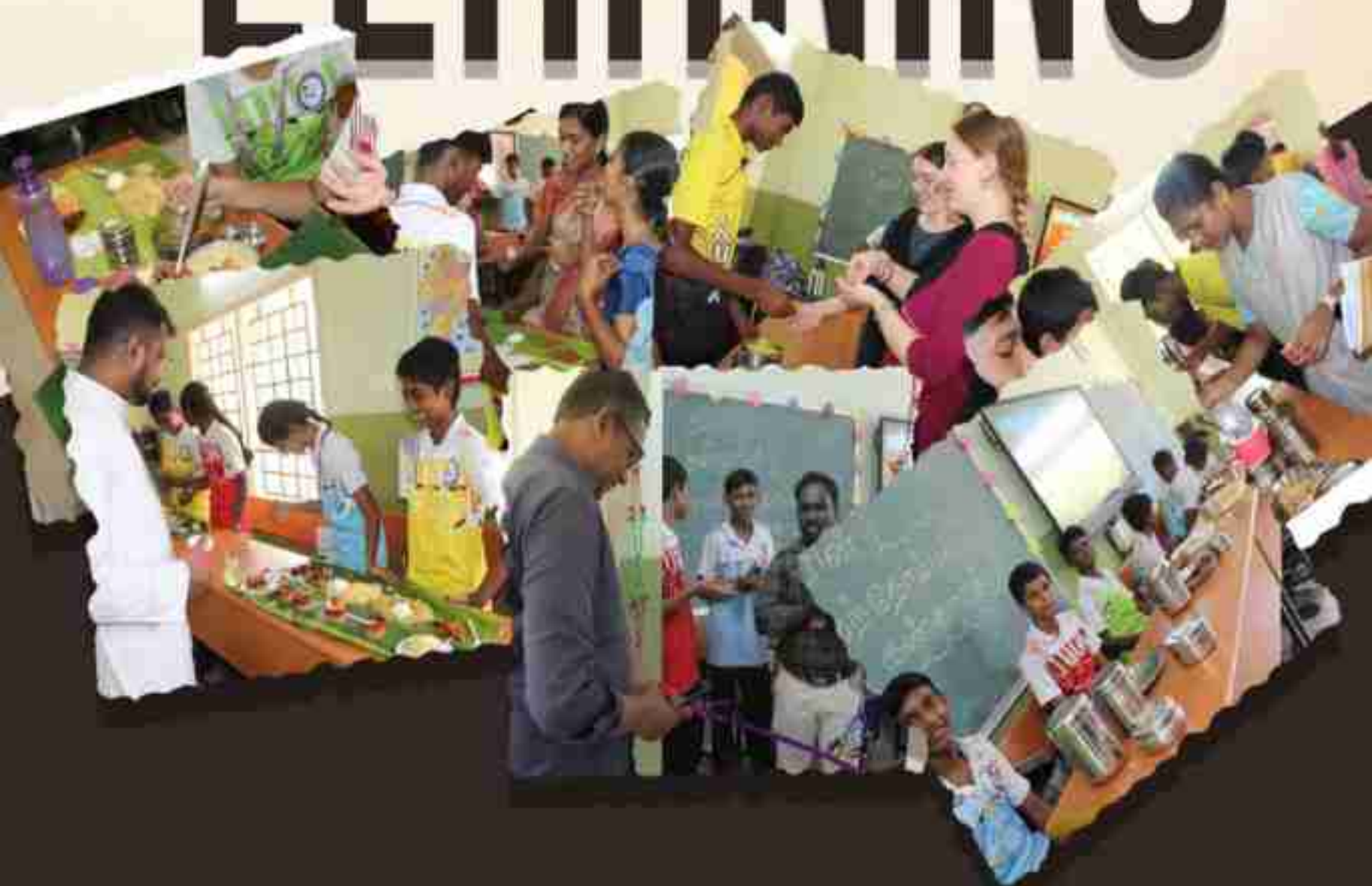


Celebrating the Legacy of K. Kamarajar

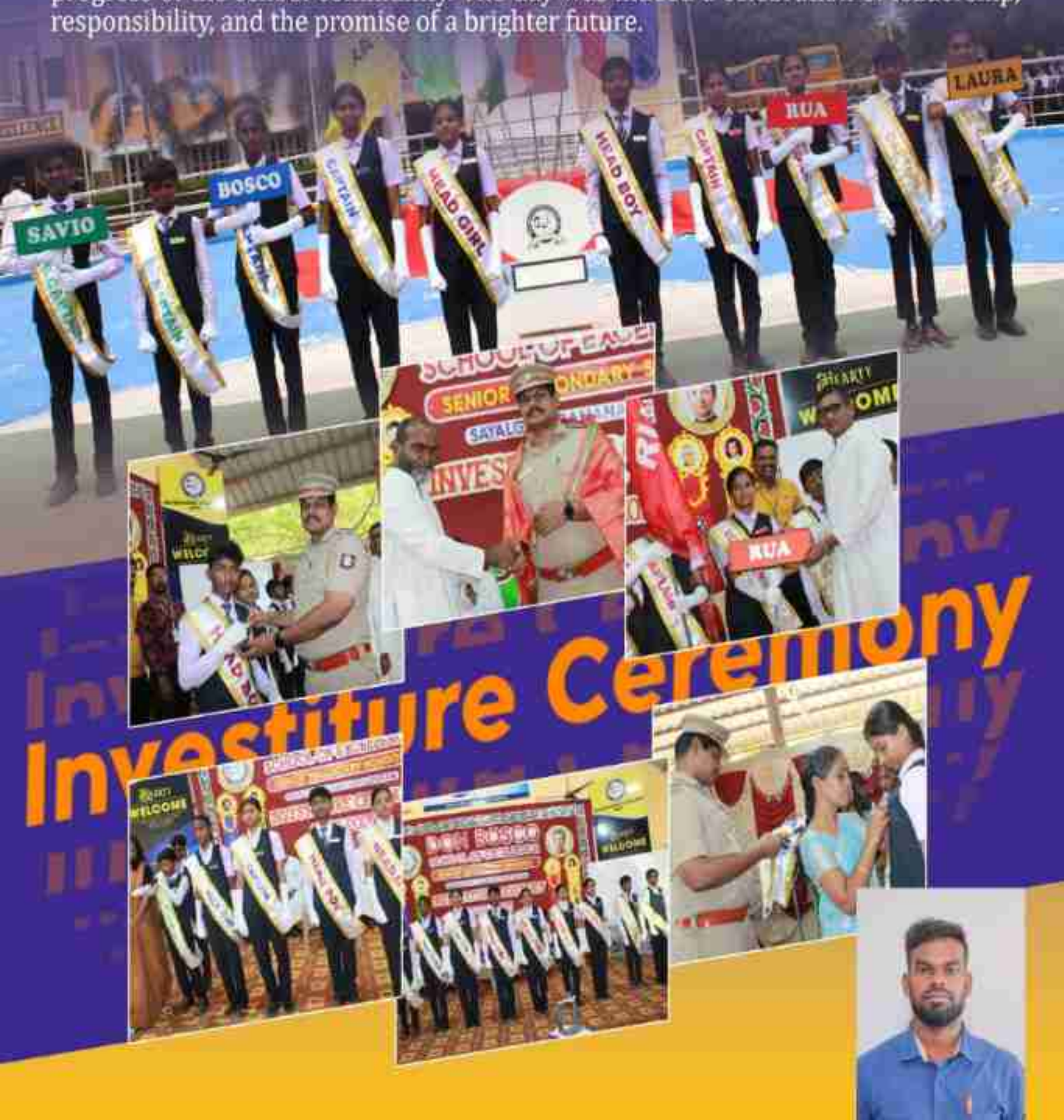
Seminar on Memory Techniques
